2021 COVID-19 EVENT PROCEDURES Updated May 12, 2021

PLEASE READ EVERYTHING BELOW

Failure to comply with these rules will result in forfeit of race entry and immediate removal from the premises, potentially without prior warning.

Please bring your own face covering to the event. We have a limited supply in case of emergencies.

Pre-Registration is required for all events. No walk-up registration.

FACE COVERING RULES:

ENTRY GATE WAIVER STATION - Face covering is MANDATORY when interacting with Staff at the Entry Gate. Please stay inside your vehicle. You must use the Speedwaiver option or complete an SCCA Annual Waiver to eliminate the need to sign the paper waiver at the gate. You will be handed a red wristband that you must display at all times during the event. If you have registered for both days of a two day event you will need to get a new wristband each day.

TECH - Face covering is MANDATORY when going through Tech. Please stay inside your vehicle and follow instructions from Tech.

REGISTRATION - Face covering is MANDATORY while in line and at the registration table. Please try to keep 6 feet back, and only come to registration if you need a new barcode. If possible, car classing changes should be done online prior to the event by updating MSR or emailing the registrar.

WORK ASSIGNMENTS - Your work assignment will be emailed to you in advance, so there will be no wristbands distributed in the morning. Please check in as usual before going to your work assignment, and be mindful of social distancing while doing so.

GRID - Face covering is MANDATORY when outside of your vehicle. This will be strictly enforced. After your first warning, you will be asked to leave and you will not receive a refund. **Do not enter the Timing Truck** if you have a question about a time, please ask one of the grid workers to contact an event official for assistance.

PADDOCK - Face covering is MANDATORY when socializing within 10 feet of each other. If you are alone or maintaining proper distance from others, a face covering is not required.

COURSE - Face covering is optional if you are maintaining proper distance (10 feet) from others. You should be spread out while working the course anyway. There will be

hand sanitizer at all stations. Course Captains will spray the radio, flag and other contact items with the spray bottle in the worker bucket before leaving their post.

WAIVERS – This is important enough to repeat....The event waiver must be COMPLETED BEFOREHAND. You will NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER without first completing the SpeedWaiver or having an annual waiver 'hard card' to show upon entry.

SpeedWaiver - Everyone must complete THIS DIGITAL WAIVER (link will be emailed to you when you register) before arriving on site, unless you have an SCCA annual waiver card. It replaces the paper waiver you used to sign at the gate. Use your cell phone for the best experience, as you need to take a selfie and physically "sign" it. You will need to show the completed digital waiver at the gate, so TAKE A SCREENSHOT for easy access. You can apply anytime before the start of the event.

OTHER ITEMS

PASSENGERS - We are allowing passengers ONLY for family members of the same household or co-drivers in the same car.

SPECTATORS - We are limiting spectators to only those who are participating as drivers in the event or attending as a "crew" member of a driver. Please help us maintain social distancing by limiting the number of spectators at events for the time being.

FOOD & WATER - Food & water will NOT be provided. Please bring your own, or stop somewhere to buy it BEFORE you arrive on site. It will be HOT, so bring at least 6 bottles of water per person. We will most likely have a lunch break, but it will not be long enough to leave the site to grab food.
